

Well Water Testing, Certified Water Labs

MN Administrative Rule 9502.0445. Subpart 1. Water

There must be a safe water supply in the residence. **Water from privately owned wells must be tested annually** by a Minnesota Health Department certified laboratory for **coliform bacteria and nitrate nitrogens** to verify safety. The provider shall file a record of the test results with the agency. Retesting and corrective measures may be required by the agency if results exceed state drinking water standards or where the supply may be subject to off-site contamination.
