Check-out timeframe

Each request will be scheduled in 2-week increments. Your equipment will arrive on Wednesday or Thursday the week before your program begins and will be picked up on a Tuesday or Wednesday after the 2nd full week of check-out. If there is a need and we have availability, we may be able to fulfill longer requests. All equipment will be picked up by August 15th.
