

## Substitute, Second Adult Caregiver, Helper Initial and Ongoing Training Tracking

Documenting training hours and tracking substitute hours each year are required. This document is <u>an optional form</u> to track that information.

Definitions	
Second Adult Caregiver	<ul> <li>18<sup>+</sup>-year-old who works in a program with the license holder present</li> <li>Can work unlimited number hours in a program each license year</li> <li>Training requirements increase once individual works 500+ hours in calendar year</li> </ul>
Substitute	<ul> <li>18<sup>+</sup>-year-old who works in the program with the license holder absent</li> <li>License holder may use a cumulative total of 500 hours of substitute care per calendar year</li> <li>Substitute name, days, and hours worked must be tracked</li> </ul>
Helper	<ul> <li>13- to 17-year-old who assists with care of children, but does not supervise children</li> <li>Helpers can be used an unlimited number of hours each license year</li> </ul>
Emergency Replacement	<ul> <li>18<sup>+</sup>-year-old with no known criminal or child protective issues</li> <li>No background study or training requirements prior to emergency use</li> <li>Used for care of children in true emergency situation where provider must leave/unable to provide care</li> <li>Must close program due to emergency and report use of emergency replacement to licensor within 7 days</li> </ul>
