### Age Group Definitions MN Statute 142B.01, subd 13

#### All License Categories:

I = Infant, 6 weeks to less than 12 months

P = Preschooler, 24 months to school age

S = School age, at least 5 yrs to less than 11 yrs

#### Family and Group Family Day Care

##### A, C(1), C(2), C(3):

T = Toddler, 12 months to less than 24 months

##### Specialized Infant & Toddler B(1), B(2), D

T\* = Toddler, 12 months to less than 30 months

#### Newborn care

Newborn = birth to 6 weeks

When a newborn is in care that is NOT the provider's child, and only 1 adult caregiver is present, the newborn shall be the only child under 12 months and there shall be no more than two other children present.

#### Operating License Classification

- A can operate at A
- C1 can operate at C1
- C2 can operate at C1 or C2
- C3 can operate at C1 or C2 or C3\*
- B1 can operate at B1
- B2 can operate at B1 or B2
- D can operate B1 or B2 or D\*

\*can only operate at D and C3 with approved two caregivers present
