#### **Smoke Detectors**

- Use interconnected, hardwired detectors when possible
- Write the date of manufacture on the outside of all alarms in bold marker
- Replace batteries annually for detectors that are not 10-year sealed battery
- Replace all detectors at least every 10 years, or sooner if they fail
- It's highly recommended to test smoke detectors with fire drills

#### **Carbon Monoxide Detectors**

- Replace batteries annually
- Write the date of manufacture on the outside of all alarms in bold marker
- Replace detectors every 7 years (follow manufacturer guidance), or sooner if they fail
- CO detectors are required in ALL adult foster care homes
- It's highly recommended to test CO detectors monthly

## Flashlight and Weather Radio

- Must be easily accessible and operational in case of emergency
- Cell phones may be used as a flashlight, but not weather radio
- Radio must operate without electricity
- It's highly recommended to test these monthly
