

Incident and Required Reporting

Serious Injuries – 9555.6175 and 9555.6225

- Fractures and dislocations of bones
- Evidence of internal injuries
- •Irreversible mobility or avulsion of teeth
- Near drowning
- Attempted suicide

- •Extensive 2nd or 3rd degree burns
- •Extensive 2nd or 3rd degree frostbite
- Eyeball injuries
- Heat exhaustion/sunstroke
- Lacerations to tendons/organs when complications are present
- •Head injuries with loss of consciousness or potential for closed head injury, or head injury without loss of consciousness requiring a medical assessment
- •All other injuries considered serious after an assessment by a health care professional including but not limited to: self-injurious behavior, medication error requiring medical treatment, complication of a previous injury

Incidents - 9555.6245, Subp. 5

An incident report must be written resident requires emergency care, when a police report of an incident involving a resident has been made, or when a complaint has been filed under the Vulnerable Adults Act. All incident reports must be entered in the resident's file within 8 hours.

Reporting

Within 8 hours: notify your RLS of any situation that is considered a serious injury or incident.

Within 8 hours: If a physician has determined that refusal or failure to take a medication as prescribed creates an immediate thread of health or safety to the resident or others notify the resident's physician and legal representative of the refusal or failure to take medication as prescribed. Also notify the resident's physician and legal representative of any adverse medication reaction.

Within 24 hours: Notify your RLS of any fire that causes structural damage or requires assistance from the fire department
